Topic Overview

- We will be learning to recognise and write our names

- Start learning phonics and to apply phonics to read and write cvc words

- We will be saying and using number names in order to 10/20
- We will recognise numerals 0 -10
- We will order numbers 1- 10
- We will use the language of more and less
- We will count objects reliably to 6
- We will create a representation for numbers 1 − 6
- We will learn to write numbers 1 − 6
