

# Year Three—Spring Curriculum Overview



## Topic Overview

This term our theme is Wild Animals, closely linked to our Science topic on Animals and Humans. We will be focusing on Wolves in particular and finding out facts about them using different research techniques. We will apply these skills into our writing creating non fiction information pages about these wild animals. We will think carefully about the different environment wolves can live in and how they survive in them. We will be reading a variety of different types of texts and make comparisons between different features.

## Core Subjects

**English** - Our first text is a picture book called Wolves by Emily Gravett— It's a fiction book with an alternative ending to the story. We will be creating our own alternative ending. Then we will be reading the story The Ice Palace by Robert Swindells— recreating a scene from the story. The final text we will use is The True story of the Three Little Pigs— retelling the story from the point of view of the wolf

**Maths** - We are focusing on place value, addition and subtraction, as well as some multiplication and division. We will continue to develop our knowledge of fractions and our times tables so we become more fluent

**Science** - Animals—inc humans. Our focus is nutrition, growth, Muscles and the skeleton.
