Topic Overview

Literacy Communication & Language

We will continue working on building up our levels of attention, using bucket time to develop focus and continuing to engage in story telling, sharing stories and making simple story maps to write about them. We will continue to develop our language skills, learning new vocabulary.

Mathematical Development

We will continue to subitise quantities up to 5 in different contexts. We will begin to explore five frames in different contexts and will sing songs and rhymes using numbers and act them out.
