



Year 2 Summer 1 Curriculum Overview

Topic Overview

Alver Valley went to the farm! This term, the children will be exploring writing recounts linked with our trip to the farm.

Core Subjects

English: We will be writing a recount following on from our trip to Manor Farm early in the term. We will also be writing a letter based on the book 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley'.

Maths: We will be learning to read the time to the nearest five minutes. We will also be looking at position and direction and comparing shapes. We will also learn about measure (capacity, temperature and mass).

Science: Plants. We will be looking at the life cycle of plants, how they grow and what they need to survive.

RE: Stories from the major 6 religions

P4C/ PSHE: Health and wellbeing: why is sleep important.

PE: Athletics

History: We will be looking at important women from history, focusing on Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale.
